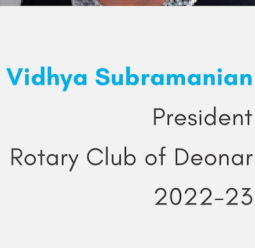

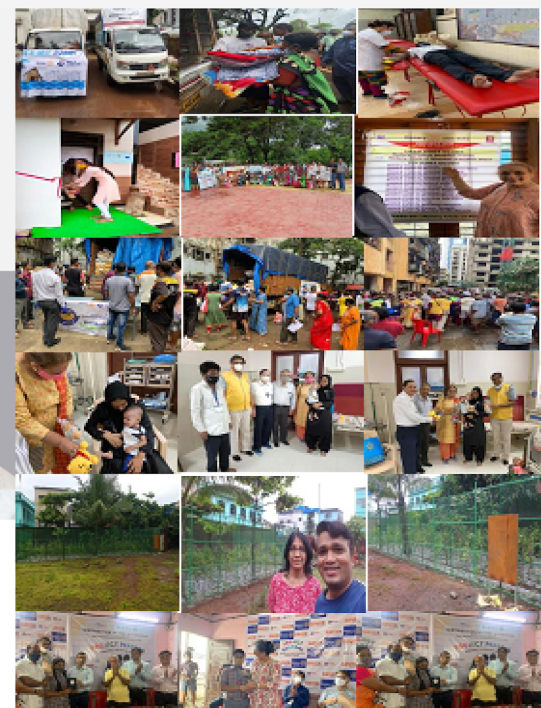

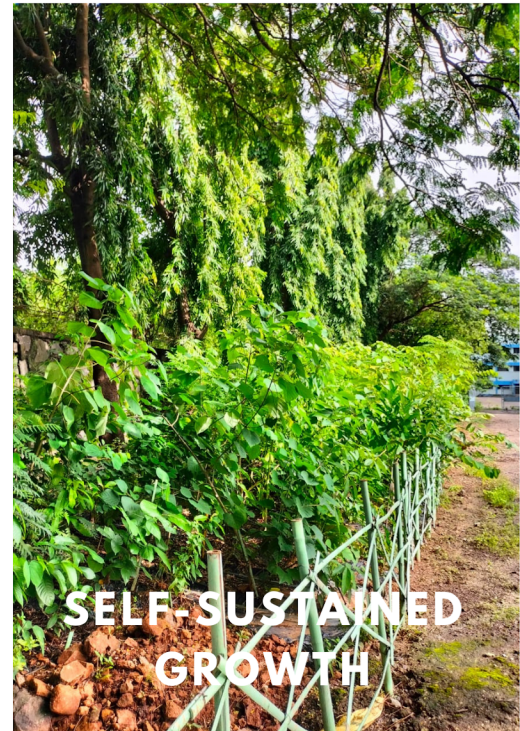

Creating Oxygen Cylinders in our backyard

- Using saplings of native species thereby lesser absorption of ground water, quick growth, reaches functional in 2 years, low mortality, high productivity
- Low Maintenance unlike gardens, these forests will have self growth and very minimal or no maintenance required after 2 years
- Creation of habitat for birds and other species
- Reducing carbon foot print of concrete jungle

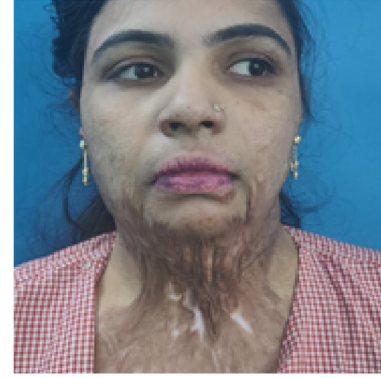

OPERATION RESTORE

Free Burns Corrective Surgeries since 2010

- Free Corrective Surgeries that restore functional capabilities to burn survivors
- They would otherwise be left to die or live in poverty and perennial dependence
- Includes post-surgery counselling and support in getting employment or setting up a small business
- Program to be scaled to cover 120 burn survivors across other states and countries
