

ACHIEVEMENTS FOR R.I YEAR 20-21

The project achieved the following despite the lockdown situation thus proving that service to the society can be done from home too!

For Phase 1, the major milestones include:


- A. Construction of a Hygiene and Sanitation Center worth 5
 Lakh INR
- B. Supported the women with 6 motorized stitching machines worth 1 Lakh INR
- C. Sponsored professional Stitching courses for upto 20 women worth 90,000 INR
- D. Provided Umbrella fabric to stitch 10,000 bags and support sales efforts
- E. Provided the community center 60 Chairs, 10 Tables and 4 Cupboards for social gatherings of the villagers
- F. Set-up of a Projector with Sound system for weekly activities

The project was also widely appreciated by Rotary, Local gram panchayat at Jamshet and was awarded the Best Community Service Project by both the South Asia Information Centers (RSA MDIO and SEARIC MDIO)



VISION 22-23 AND BEYOND

- Regular supply of clean drinking water system with purification plant to be installed or maintained
- Growing vegetables with solar energy for irrigation.
 Vegetable plant nursery to distribute healthy saplings to small farmers
- Bachat Gat formation for supplementary family income
 & avoid harsh bricklin bonded labor work
- Efforts to provide free basic education & healthcare, amenities etc. Organize visits of locals for exposure to the outside world
- Organize visits of local administration/dignitaries and other school children to create awareness of ground reality
- To stress the importance of personal cleanliness and hygiene to improve personal health
- Programmes to stress ecological/environment importance, on the local level to avoid deforestation in sensitive thick jungle areas around
- Development of a community centre (Samaj Mandir): a gathering place (at present, under construction), equipped with basic amenities, books, entertainment, library etc. with evening classes
