This auspicious occasion, held on 17th July 2025, was graced by District Governor Rtn Dr. Manish Motwani, RC Deonar President Rtn Alka Murli, RCC President Rtn V. Kannan, and an enthusiastic Team Deonar, whose presence underlined the importance of strengthening community-led service. These five RCCs together span 46 villages, each with unique challenges and strengths, yet united by a shared dream of progress and self-reliance. Each RCC functions as the extended arm of Rotary in remote locations, where local citizens come forward as change-makers. It was a celebration of trust placed in local leadership and a renewed vow of collaboration between Rotary Club of Deonar and its rural counterparts.
